Our Mission: To ensure the Safety of ALL children as they enter and leave the school grounds. Also, to promote the safe drop off and pick up of students in as expeditious manner as possible.

We ask that all parents abide by the following Rules in our parking lot:

* Be courteous and patient - <u>safety should be everyone's first priority</u>.

* If everyone works together and follows the rules, the line will move swiftly.

*Speed Limit: 5 mph

*Only drop off and pick up students in the pickup line.

* Do not have your student walk through the parking lot without an adult.

*<u>Drivers should NOT get out of their cars</u> (if you need to get out, then you need to park your car).

*Do NOT double park.

*Do NOT go the wrong way through the parking lot (to try to get around the 'pick up line'... this is very dangerous!).

*When dropping off, do not park in the no parking area's to watch your child go to class (if you want to watch your child, then please park and walk in with them).

*Do NOT park in the handicap parking spaces unless you have a handicapped placard.

*Students MUST get in or out of the car as quickly as possible WITH their school gear ready.

*At pick up, this is not the time to discuss the day's events. This delays the line, please talk with your child AFTER they are in the car as you drive home.


*At pickup time students MUST get into the car quickly (not playing, talking or not paying attention this causes a delay to the line).

*Students should NOT cross Main Street or Bond Street without being accompanied by an adult.

* Be considerate of others

Parents, Please Adhere to our Parking Lot Rules for the SAFETY of our STUDENTS!

This area is not for parking. It should not be used for picking up or dropping off kids. By stopping in this area you are obstructing pedestrians and cars waiting at the stop sign. This could result in someone getting hurt.

On divided highways, a single solid white line will usually be used to indicate the rightmost boundary of the drivable roadway. You should not drive to the right of this line. Sets of solid white lines are frequently used to divide the lanes before an upcoming hazard such as a road obstruction caused by the pillar of an over-crossing, or the median between a freeway off-ramp and normal traffic lanes. Again, these lines should not be crossed.
